In our Cinema Lounge, you can watch **Boom for Real**, the acclaimed documentary about Haitian-American artist Jean-Michel Basquiat. 

A mix of Dennis on acoustic guitar, piano, harmonium and vocals, Akoustik shows a new side of this man's formidable talents – live in concert on our stage, Akoustik-style.






